On 14 November 2013, Easton White, a visiting Fulbright Scholar at the University of Victoria working with the [Baum Lab](#) <sup>[2]</sup>, led a workshop on implementing ecological population models. As examples of mathematical models in biology, Easton talked about some of his research, which has covered a wide range of biological systems, including work on pikas (*Ochotona princeps*), in California, and lemon sharks (*Negaprion brevirostris*) in the Bahamas.
